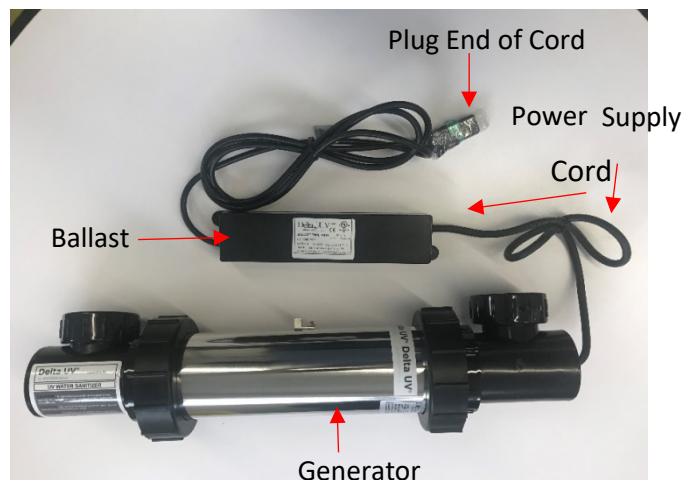


STEPS TO DISCONNECT DELTA UV EA-4H-10 GENERATOR

1. Turn off the circuit breaker supplying power to the generator and the pool, spa, or other product in which the generator was installed.

WARNING: TO AVOID ELECTRICAL SHOCK, YOU MUST TURN OFF POWER TO THE CIRCUIT BEFORE GOING TO THE NEXT STEP. 2. Locate the generator installed in your pool, spa or other product. The generator performs water filtration, so the unit will be located in the area where the water supply is connected to your pool, spa, or other product. A photograph of a generator is reproduced below:

3. Locate the power supply cord of the generator located at one end of the unit as shown in the above photo.

4. With the power shut off at the circuit panel, unplug the power cord from the power receptacle. Then return the power to your pool, spa or other product by turning the circuit breaker back on.

5. To ensure that the generator is not plugged back into the power source before the product is serviced, attach the supplied sticker or hang tag to either the generator, or where the generator plugs into the power supply.
